GENERAL MOVE IN INFORMATION

AII EXHIBITORS

- Credentials are not required for move-in however all personnel should carry a state issued photo
 ID at all times.
- Exhibit move-in will begin on Saturday, January 4.

 You will be notified by email of your specific targeted, move in/out dates & times by December 13, 2024. PLEASE note your specific move-in target day and time.
- Exhibitors must arrive at least 30 minutes prior to their targeted time.
- All vehicles must be removed from the building immediately after unloading.
- Carpet Installation—If you are not using the Decorator (Demers Exposition) to install/remove
 your carpet you must abide by the carpet installation times found on the move-in schedule.
- ALL CARPET MUST BE LAID IN ADVANCE OF YOUR MOVE IN TIME.

BOAT/BULK MOVE IN PROCEDURES

- Staging boats—South Parking Lot, Friday, January 3rd from 8am 6pm.
 (You may only stage boats 24 hours prior to your move in day/time, not prior due to limited staging space available.)
- Exhibitor must be on hand to supervise boat placement within the exhibit space.
- Cranes will be on-site starting Friday, January 3rd from 9am 3pm to off load boats from trailers. Crane trucks will be available to work on the show floor, installing bridges, stepping masts and unloading boats.
- Dual 10k forklifts will be on site Saturday to Monday to offload smaller boats.
